This year will commemorate the 120th Anniversary of the Boonton Volunteer Fire Department. Since 1891 your Boonton Volunteer Fire Department has proudly served our community. The Department is steeped in tradition and boasts a membership of over 200 volunteer men and women. With the finest state of the art equipment, our volunteers remain prepared twenty-four hours and day, seven days a week to serve you in your time of need.

During 2010, the Department responded to **310 alarms**. These alarms include structure fires, motor vehicle accidents requiring extrication with the Jaws of Life, vehicle fires, hazardous material incidents, carbon monoxide alarms, flooded basements, brush fires, police assists and mutual aid requests.

In order to be best prepared to respond to this wide array of incidents, a structured year long training program is adhered to. In addition to meticulously caring for our five pieces of firefighting equipment, this training program, which consumes hundreds of volunteer hours, allows us to best be prepared for any emergency that you or your family may encounter.

The Boonton Fire Department is also an integral part of our community sponsoring both children's Halloween and Christmas parade, numerous little league teams, and annually providing three scholarships to local High School seniors who wish to further their education. Additionally, with the help of our new partner "Sparky the Fire Dog" a remote controlled mascot we have implemented a Fire Prevention Program delivered to our community's children.
